AN ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A UNIFORM RATE FOR PARKING METERS IN THE CITY OF SCRANTON AND THEREBY AMENDING FILE OF THE COUNCIL NO. 78, 1994 TO ESTABLISH THE UNIFORM RATE OF \$.50 AN HOUR AT ALL METERS.

WHEREAS, the rate for parking at meters in the City of Scranton varies depending on the street; and

WHEREAS, many streets carry a \$.25 an hour parking fee, while other streets carry a fee of \$.50 an hour for parking at meters; and

WHEREAS, increasing rates at all meters, not otherwise at the \$.50 an hour rate, would result in an increase in revenue to the City and standardize parking meter rates throughout the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCRANTON that the fees for all parking meters are hereby established as \$.50 an hour, thereby Amending File of the Council No. 78 of 1994 to change the rate of all meters not otherwise already at the \$.50 an hour rate.

SECTION 1. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion. The City reserves the right to amend this Ordinance or any portion thereof from time to time as it shall deem advisable in the best interest of the promotion of the purposes and intent of this Ordinance, and the effective administration thereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is enacted by the Council of the City of Scranton under the authority of the Act of Legislature, April 13, 1972, Act No. 62, known as the "Home Rule Charter and Option Plans Law" and any other applicable law arising under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.
