AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING FILE OF THE COUNCIL NO. 41, 1987, ENTITLED "PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF PARKING METERS; ESTABLISHING METER ZONES AND HOURS OF OPERATION; PROVIDING FOR THE OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND INSTALLATION OF METERS AND PARKING METER RATES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SCRANTON POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENFORCE COLLECTION OF REVENUE FROM FINES AND METERS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF" BY AMENDING SECTION 3.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Scranton, that Section 3, of File of Council No. 41, 1987 (as amended) shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Parking Meter Rates, Meter Zones and Hours of Operation-Holidays

TWO-HOUR METERS - 50¢ PER HOUR

Delete: 100 Penn Avenue (Easterly Side), beginning at the corner of Penn Avenue and Lackawanna Avenue

SECTION 2. In all other respects, File of Council No. 41, 1987 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance so long as it remains legally enforceable minus the invalid portion.
